

RHRC Pre-Test Board Meeting
May 13, 2021

Betsy called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM

Attendance: Betsy Reali, Doug Gallucci, Jean Fowler, Dianne Clark, Eric Marec, Cindy Olson, Liz Gibson, Sue Meyring, Susan Bell, Bill Woll

This meeting was called to finalize plans for the upcoming HRT on May 22, 23, 2021.

- ✓ Property Utilization: Stakes will be assigned specific pieces of property. Susan has a map made by Eric and she will outline locations for each stake. Issues to consider include: equipment, possibility of whistle/gunshot interference. The live shot flyer location is critical.
- ✓ Insurance Waiver – Will Hart is waiting to receive it. After discussion it was resolved that Betsy will email a copy of the waiver to Will. We are covered for this test (until the end of June). Payment will be made by Susan Bell.
- ✓ Susan Bell has the checkbook and since Sue Meyring is out of town, Susan will write 2 checks – one to Will Hart for Ground use during the test (\$1,150 - \$200 deposit already made) and one to Equisure (\$600).
- ✓ ATV Insurance?: Equisure will cover injury of a person injured while riding an ATV (\$5K) and damage to the ATV. We will provide an insurance waiver that users of the ATV must sign. Betsy will find a template on the web and have it ready on Friday.
- ✓ Bird Order: AKC rule requires 2 birds on site for every dog. Wendy's husband is driving to CA to get more birds and Wendy will bring 100 more birds than we ordered. She will sell these birds to Doug Shade for their Memorial Day test on Sauvie Island. We will meet the AKC regulations.
- ✓ Parking Monitor/Guidelines: Vehicles must stay on roads or the perimeter of property. Do not drive through the field. There will be a road to the apple tree and one for 5th wheel trailers to use for turning around. Instructions/Guidelines will be handed out to everyone when they arrive.
- ✓ Helpers: Andy Fontenau has 4 workers. They are over 16, have worked at hunt tests before. They will cost the club \$150/day. They are coming and will sleep in a tent. We think we have enough sleeping bags (Sue, Doug, Betsy) and cots. Sue, 2, Doug 1, Susan1). Susan may have a

blow up bed that she will check for leaks. The club will provide the helpers with dinner on Saturday night and Breakfast on Sunday morning. Lunches will be provided at the stakes where they work. Sue and Betsy offered to let the boys have showers at their homes.

- Katie Quarles also volunteered to help in Master A.

- Robin and Scott Conley (?) called and offered to help. Liz will talk to them about being Stake Chairs for Master A.

✓PSLRA had their Marshals on Channel 1. Then each stake was on its own channel. Maybe the radio on Channel 1 should be for the Stake chairs?

✓EGRC/Fast Grass – If EGRC wants to contribute to the payment for the Fast Grass their portion would be approximately \$64. Susan contacted Linda Johnson and they want to use the Fast Grass as well. Sue M will send RHRC portion for the Fast Grass to Cindy Olson.

✓Starbucks Gift Cards – Final decision was to purchase 10 cards @ \$10 each to recognize outstanding help.

✓Budget Planning – We will ask Cindy Olson to share the spread sheet she uses for PSLRA HRT planning.

✓Birds – We will euthanize 20 birds before starting the test. Jim will ask Colin to borrow Jerry's apparatus to do this humanely.

✓Jerry Leitch Dedication – Dianne heard back from Tara that the nice piece on Jerry will be in the catalog. There may not be an extra charge.

✓Judge Gifts – Betsy purchased RHRC pencils that will be included with Judges' Gifts, Jr. Handlers and Sheila Leitch.
